dignity and self-worth of each student and encourages an understanding of pediculosis and its effects;

- 2.1.4 support the student(s) and parent(s)/guardian(s) in providing head lice treatment and education, and may excuse from school, a student with head lice, for the purpose of receiving a head lice treatment, following notification to the parent(s)/guardian(s); and
- 2.1.5 re-check the student(s) who had head lice, upon the student(s)'s return to school, in accordance with the school's pediculosis plan, to ensure that the student(s) is free of live head lice for re-admission to class.

3. Treatment of Pediculosis

- 3.1 The principal shall:
 - advise the parent(s)/guardian(s) of a student with head lice, that it is the parent's(s')/guardian's(s') responsibility to treat the student(s), with the goal that the treatment renders the student(s) free of head lice;
 - 3.1.2 encourage the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the student(s) with head lice, to examine all members of the family for head lice and to provide treatment if necessary;
