1. OBJECTIVE

Administration and teaching staff shall support opportunities for students to become knowledgeable about and to gain experience in political affairs.

- 5.4.8 Political activity must not, at any time, imtere with the normal operation of the school unless supported by the Board.
- 5.5 Political Study, Discussion and Debate
 - 5.5.1 Staff will encourage a broad range of informed points of wireall political activities.
 - 5.5.2 Opportunities for political study within the curriculum should be encouraged and enhancement be consistent with curriculum expectations.
 - 5.5.3 Staff will not take advantage of their positions of influence, during any school or classroom activities, to promote partisan activity ovp.oients.
 - 5.5.4 Staff will act in a highly professional manner in any discussion of political matters during school and classroom activities, and refrain from denigrating, promoting or proselytizing any political views.
 - 5.5.5 It is recognized that beyond the school, political activities are a personal matter. It is expected that staff will demonstrate sincerity, judgement and respect for human rights and the opinions of others, in such activities.
